Will Gillespie is a very genuine writer and performer. What you see and hear onstage is a candid, off-the cuff sometimes clever sometimes charming sometimes touching "Nice Guy" persona that is uniquely his own. There's something for everybody at a Will Gillespie show. Some enjoy his varied chord voicings and finger-picking techniques, while others like the natural, conversational vocal delivery or concise, crafted lyrics. Some like the occasional bad joke and self-deprecating humour in the banter. The whole performance seems unforced and neither forces itself upon you. More inviting and disarming.
